





- Fully disassemble goals for seasonal storage.





7. Mark ground anchor hole locations on the ground to prepare for digging.


OVERHEAD VIEW

- 8. Dig the holes in the locations marked in the previous step large enough to accommodate the ground sleeves and anchors as shown below.
- 9. Fill the bottom of each hole with clean stone (1/4" 3/4") [0.6cm 2cm) to the levels shown to allow for water drainage. Hand tamp to create a flat base.



10. Before placing the adjustable ground sleeve boxes in the ground, apply masking tape to the drainage holes on the bottom of the boxes to prevent concrete seepage into box. Identify the left and right adjustable ground sleeves boxes by checking the orientation of the tilt adjustment screw shaft, which must always angle towards the outside of the goal.



11. Check that the ground sleeve tilt adjustment in each ground sleeve box is in the neutral position by aligning the center of the ground sleeve with the neutral mark on the rim of the box. If needed, adjust the sleeve using the supplied socket driver and 11/16" socket by following the guide below.





13. Check that the posts' height adjustment is in the neutral position by measuring 2" [51 mm] between the bottom of the post and the bottom of the height adjustment sleeve. If necessary, adjust the height adjustment sleeve using the supplied socket driver and 8mm socket by following the guide below.




- 14. Place a 12-16 gallon heavy duty trash bag over each ground sleeve box and cut a hole for the goal posts to pass through, and use masking tape to tape over the drainage hole on the backpole ground sleeves to prevent concrete seepage into sleeves.
- 15. Insert the assembled goal posts into the adjustable ground sleeve boxes in the ground, passing the posts through the holes in the trash bags. Place the back pole ground sleeves and backpoles in the ground. Brace back poles to prevent them from falling over before concrete is poured. Make sure the goal is centered in the field with the face of the goal flush with the goal line.





18. Attach the ground frame anchors to the ground frame as shown below, passing the anchor bolt through the ground frame slot covers and slots in each base. Position the anchor in the middle of the slot. Ensure that the top of the anchor remains 3/4" [20 mm] below the field surface by using the ground frame anchor spacer.



19. Plumb/level the entire goal following steps 19a and 19b. These steps must be done together to ensure all parts of the goal are equally plumb/level.

NOTE: DO NOT USE THE POST HEIGHT ADJUSTMENTS OR GROUND SLEEVE TILT ADJUSTMENTS TO HELP PLUMB/LEVEL GOAL. ANY ADJUSTMENTS MADE TO HEIGHT OR TILT SHOULD BE DONE WITH STONE IN THE BOTTOM OF THE ANCHOR HOLE ONLY.

19a. Make sure the posts are exactly 24'-3/16" [7320 mm] apart at the bottom, that the crossbar is 8'0" [2438 mm] above field surface and level, and that the face of the goal post is flush with the goal line. Add/remove stone as needed to correct their positions, ensuring all ground sleeves remain 3/4" [20 mm] below the field surface.



19b. Check that the adjustable ground sleeve boxes are plumb by leveling them side to side and front to back. Add/remove stone as needed to correct their positions.

20. Before pouring concrete, seal open areas by wrapping the posts, back poles, ground frame, and top of the ground sleeve boxes with plastic wrap, tape, or any other suitable barrier at ground level to protect the parts from concrete while pouring. Secure the trash bag and any plastic/wrap used in place above the concrete line shown in step 9.

NOTE: FAILURE TO PROTECT COMPONENTS WHILE POURING CONCRETE MAY CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE GOAL.

21. Fill the holes with concrete to the levels shown in steps 8-9. While pouring concrete, agitate the concrete to relieve air for a better foundation, and make sure posts and back poles stay plumb. After the concrete has fully cured, see step 22 for test procedures to ensure the goal has been anchored properly.

NOTE: THE FLOWING CONCRETE WILL CAUSE PARTS TO SHIFT IF NOT PROPERLY HELD IN PLACE.



22. After installing, test as described below to verify effectiveness of anchor system. If applicable, allow concrete to fully cure before testing.

ANCHOR TEST

- 1. Clear all persons from a minimum 50 foot radius surrounding the goal.
- 2. Verify goal is attached to anchors according to instruction.
- 3. Apply a horizontal pull force of 248 lbs. to the center of the crossbar for 60 70 seconds. Full safety precautions must be taken while performing test.
- 4. If goal overturns during application of force or does not return to an upright position after removing force, an alternate anchoring system must be used



23. Create a cutout for the ground sleeve on each of the plastic barriers by placing a ground sleeve box slide cap centered over top of the plastic barrier, and then using the opening of slide cap as a guide to cut the plastic barrier with a utility knife.


NOTE: Making the cutout slightly smaller than the opening of the cap creates a better, tighter fit.



- 24. Once concrete has set, remove all protective plastic from all components and remove the goal frame from the ground sleeves. Use a rod to punch out the masking tape put over the drainage holes on each anchor to allow for drainage.
- 25. Install the box caps on each of the adjustable ground sleeve boxes as shown below. It may be necessary to temporarily remove the set screw on the ground sleeve to install the sliding cap.

26. Install the plastic barrier over the top of each box and box cap. Use a utility knife to cut a small X to push the adjustment screw through. Attach the included rubber tube to the cap using a plastic cable tie as shown below (Note: lightly wetting the inside of the rubber tubing may help slide it in place more easily). Once secure, cut off excess cable tie using scissors.




27. Once the cap, plastic barrier, and rubber tube are installed the goal can be re-inserted and the anchor holes can be back-filled. The rubber tube can be trimmed flush with the field surface if needed once the holes are backfilled.



- 28. Once concrete has set, remove all protective plastic from the back poles and remove them from the anchors. Use a rod to punch out the masking tape put over the drainage holes on each anchor to allow for drainage.
- 29. Assemble the right and left back poles as shown below. Take note that the net tension winches are positioned differently on each pole.


30. Assemble the net straps onto each back pole, passing them through the net tension winches and eye bolts as shown below.

31. To attach the net to the goal, place the base of each net clip over the perimeter rope of the net and into the channel, turning 90 degrees to lock it into place. Start with the top post corners, denoted by a yellow net tag. Use a step ladder if needed to reach the crossbar.




32. Install the 1st net rope (286" long) onto the goal by weaving it around the top, rear perimeter rope of the net. Take the back pole net straps corresponding to the net tension winches on the front of the back poles and connect the snap link to the perimeter rope at the corner of the net and the 286" net rope.



Install the 2nd net rope (286" long) onto the goal by weaving it around the top, rear perimeter rope of the net & net rope installed in the previous step, starting 17 meshes in from either side of the goal. Partially raising the net using the net tension winches and straps connected in the previous step may provide easier access. Take the back pole net straps corresponding to the net tension winches on the sides of the back poles and connect the snap link to the 286" net rope only.





Remove and store the ground frame hold down hardware and ground frame spacer when the frame is in the lifted position.



42b. Grease and install the 3/8" flat tip set screws into the ground frame anchors and cover using the ground frame anchor caps to prevent debris from entering the anchors.




